


Confined Spaces Permit Required – Landscaping Infographic



CONFINED SPACE SAFETY TIPS

- ✓ **Use a Properly Calibrated Gas Detector.** Going on-site with a properly calibrated gas detector ensures your device can measure noxious gases.
- ✓ **Properly Ventilate.** If a gas detector alerts to high levels of toxic gas (or a low level of oxygen), workers need to address this quickly.
- ✓ **Have an Escape Route and Rescue Plan.**
