


Work Safely With Solvent-Based Aerosol Cleaners Infographic



CLEANING, DISINFECTING, SANITIZING

DID YOU KNOW THERE'S A DIFFERENCE?



CLEANING

Removes visible dirt, germs and impurities from surfaces. It does not kill germs, but removes them and lowers their numbers and chances to infect.



SANITIZING

Sanitizing lowers the number of germs to a safe level (according to public health standards). This usually means up to 99.99% of microorganisms. Any surface that needs sanitizing must be CLEANED first.



DISINFECTION

Disinfecting KILLS germs. Any surface that needs sanitizing must be cleaned first. Disinfecting works by using an EPA registered solution that kills 99.99% of microorganisms.
